To help grain handlers in recognizing features of grain that affect its grade, the Texas AgriLife Extension Service will hold a one-day workshop at the Texas AgriLife Research and Extension Center in Amarillo. The hands on workshop will be offered on May 4th and repeated on May 5th and will run from 9:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. The workshop will provide current grain grading standards as well as basic hands on training in grain grading of corn, sorghum and wheat.

The grain grading workshops are being co-sponsored by the Panhandle Grain and Feed Association, Texas Cattle Feeders Association, Federal Grain Inspection Service and the Texas AgriLife Extension Service.
