



CATTLE PROCESSOR

Description: Process and treat cattle on arrival and as needed during feeding period.

Supervisor Chain: 1) Head Processor 2) Cattle Manager 3) Asst Manager 4) Manager

Qualifications:

- Pass basic pre-employment physical exam and drug screen.
- Ability to read simple information and assignments in English with pen and lot numbers.
- Operation of windows based lap top programs recording medicine and cattle data.
- Ability to move and handle livestock safely and competently.
- Coordination of cattle handling with others.
- Physically capable of lifting >50 lbs and using shovel or hand tools.

Outline of Duties and Responsibilities:

- Safely move and manipulate cattle in confinement facilities for treatment in squeeze chute.
- Accurately stock and administer proper medicine and dosage following instruction and protocol.
- Administer pharmaceuticals to cattle as directed by injection, oral, or topical application.
- Apply identification and record information as required using laptop computer program.
- Cooperatively work with other members of crew assuring complete treatment or processing.
- Clean, maintain, and repair cattle working areas.
- Other duties may be assigned by supervisors.

Work Environment:

- May be exposed to weather of all kinds. Employee must provide appropriate clothing and outer wear.
- Exposure to dust from pens, roads, and mill area.
- Exposure to sharp objects used in cattle work (needles, knives, scalpels).
- Handling of cattle pharmaceuticals.
- Working near and in contact with livestock (cattle/horses).
- Operation of manual and hydraulic cattle handling equipment.
- Working in direct contact with metal and concrete fences, gates, and barriers.
- Walking and moving in areas wet and slick from manure and mud.
