



YARD MAINTENANCE LABORER/OPERATOR

Description: Maintain facilities of feed yard including pen surfaces, fences, plumbing, and structures using heavy mobil equipment and basic tools.

Supervisor Chain: 1) Yard Foreman 2) Asst Manager 3) Manager

Qualifications:

- Pass basic pre-employment physical exam and drug screen.
- Ability to read simple information and assignments in English with pen numbers.
- Basic mechanical knowledge and inclination:
 - o Routine daily maintenance of vehicles (fluids, tire pressure, filters, etc.)
 - o Ability to use simple hand tools for repairs and construction
- Physically capable of lifting >50 lbs and using shovel or hand tools
- Competency in driving large equipment (trucks, loaders, graders). Some use of standard transmissions.

Outline of Duties and Responsibilities:

- Safely operate and maintain heavy equipment in enclosed and high traffic areas.
- Assist in harvesting of manure, repair of pen and road surfaces, and transportation of material.
- Assist in repair and replacement of fencing and structures within feed yard.
- Cooperatively work with other members of crew in equipment
- Monitor and report repair needs of equipment and facilities.
- Basic repair of facilities used by employees (office, barns, break rooms)
- Other duties may be assigned by supervisors.

Work Environment:

- May be exposed to weather of all kinds. Employee must provide appropriate clothing and outer wear.
- Exposure to dust from pens, roads, and mill area
- Exposure to hot surfaces (cutting/welding of metal).
- Working near and in contact with livestock (cattle/horses).
- High traffic work areas (trucks, heavy equipment, vehicles).
- Regularly working near moving mechanical equipment.
- Uneven or slick road and pen surfaces
